JANE WISSINGER

Jane Wissinger is Professor Emerita at the University of Minnesota. She earned her B.A. from Susquehanna University, M.S. from Georgia Institute of Technology, and Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from Northwestern University. After five years as a research scientist at Rohm & Haas Co., she joined the University of Minnesota, where she transformed the organic chemistry curriculum by integrating green and sustainable chemistry, systems thinking, and the UN Sustainable Development Goals. As a Senior Principal Investigator in the NSF Center for Sustainable Polymers, she advanced sustainable plastics education and research. Her distinguished career has been recognized with numerous awards, including the ACS Fellow Award (2023) and the ACS Green Chemistry Institute Career Achievement Award (2024). She currently chairs the IUPAC Interdivisional Committee on Green Chemistry for Sustainable Development.

Mark Distefano is currently Distinguished McKnight Professor of Chemistry and Medicinal Chemistry at the University of Minnesota.

He received his B.A. degree in Chemistry and Biochemistry from the University of California at Berkeley, his Ph.D. degree from Massachusetts Institute of Technology and was a postdoctoral fellow at the California Institute of Technology. He has published more than 200 research articles, book chapters and reviews and is currently Editor in Chief for *Bioorganic Chemistry*. His current research is focused on understanding and exploiting protein lipid modification including protein prenylation.

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
